**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1. RULES**

- 1.1. The National Finals as well as all Elimination Events will be governed by the *rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
  - 1.2. The Chairman and the Area Representatives of the Event Championship Committee administer the Championship Event.
  - 1.3. The Flying Scot Class rules will be used except that RRS 60.1 (a) is changed to prohibit a boat from protesting another boat for an alleged breach of a class rule requiring class membership.
- 2. ADVERTISING** - Elimination events as well as the Nationals shall be Category A in accordance with Appendix 1, Regulation 20 - ISAF Advertising Code for all classes except Olympic Classes and any class that has elected to race under Category C in class events

**3. ELIGIBILITY AND CREW**

- 3.1. The Flying Scot Class with a crew of 3, including helmsman will be used. All competitors must be:
  - 3.1.1. Members of US SAILING for any event, and
  - 3.1.2. Members of *one* of the following:
    - 3.1.3. A Yacht Club (YC) belonging to a Sailing Association (SA) recognized by US SAILING or
    - 3.1.4. A club belonging directly to US SAILING or
    - 3.1.5. A Community Sailing Program (CSP) or other sailing organization (fleets for example) which is a member of the local SA and US SAILING.
  - 3.1.6. Members of a team must be members of a recognized Area C association. See Conditions

**4. BOATS/MEASUREMENT -**

- 4.1 The boats to be used are Flying Scot. Bring your own boat.
- 4.2 There are a limited number of boats available for Charter. Contact Area C Chair William D Bogardus for details. (see below)

**5. FEES**

- 5.1 The entry fee is \$75.00 per team (includes breakfast, on the water lunch, medals)

**9 . SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** – Sailing Instructions will be posted on the US SAILING web site in draft form and will be available at registration in final form.

**10. NUMBER OF RACES** – Maximum of Five (5) races scheduled with One (1) race constituting a series.

**11.DECISIONS OF THE PROTEST COMMITTEE**

- a. The Protest Committee may disqualify an infringing boat from all races on the day of the infringement.
- b. It is intended that decisions made by the Protest Committee are non appealable in accordance with RRS 70.5a. and USSAILING prescription to that rule. If the requirement shown on [http://raceadmin.ussailing.org/Rules/no\\_appeal/Rule\\_70\\_5\\_a\\_Procedure.htm](http://raceadmin.ussailing.org/Rules/no_appeal/Rule_70_5_a_Procedure.htm) are not meet, the decisions of the protest committee may be appealed.

**12. SAFETY**

- a. [Per US SAILING Regulation 10.04 Competitors in US SAILING championships or qualifiers for US SAILING championships shall wear a U.S. Coast Guard \(USCG\) approved personal floatation device \(PFD\) while on the water, other than for brief periods while adding or removing clothing.](#)

**13. DISCIPLINE:**

- a. Per US SAILING Regulation 10.03 A. For adult US SAILING championship events, no competitor shall use, either on or off the water marijuana or any other controlled substance

(as defined in 21 U.S. Code 802) the possession of which is unlawful under 21 U.S. Code 841.

- b. Per US SAILING Regulation 10.03 C. An alleged breach of 10.3A # 15 for adult events shall not be grounds for a protest. However, when the protest committee believes that a competitor may have breached one of these regulations, it shall follow the process described in racing rule 69.1, and a competitor found to have breached one of these regulations shall be excluded from the remaining races of the series and, where practicable, sent home. The competitor's boat shall be disqualified from all races of the series.
